Logan records wrestling sweep to win city title



Aquinas High School's Isaiah Brown is declared the winner of his 220-pound match against Logan's Nathan Bakalars on Thursday at Central High School. Logan beat both Central and Aquinas to win the city duals.

As he does after every dual or invitational, Doug Leclair expressed his excitement through a raspy voice that was almost nonexistent.

The familiar hoarse communication on Thursday included talk of team pride and motivation for the coach's Logan High School wrestling team.

That's because the Rangers are city champions for the second year in a row after sweeping dual meets from Central, Aquinas and Onalaska in the annual City Duals at Mark Sutton Memorial Gymnasium.

"It's a point of pride thing because of the teams that are here," Leclair said. "These are our neighbors, so this is a big deal for us."

Logan beat Onalaska 59-21 and swept city foes Aquinas 50-24 and Central 48-30 to improve their MVC record to 3-2 with one dual meet at Sparta remaining before the postseason.

Cody Larson (132, 138 pounds), Jaren Poff (145) and Dion Smith (160, 170) all won three times for Logan, which went largely unchallenged in emerging as champion.

The Rangers lost their first two conference duals of the season before building some steam during weekend invitationals. They went to the Wausau East Duals on Saturday and won twice while having three wrestlers go undefeated in five matches.

Logan's closest match was its third, and it had to overcome three straight losses to get it. Todd Werner (113), Alton Kammel (120) and Jake Obert (126) all won by pin to give the Red Raiders an 18-15 lead after six matches, but they managed just two more victories the rest of the way.

Christian Kapanke (138) and Smith recorded pins for Logan as it finished off Central for the championship.

"At a meet like this, I'm just looking for my kids to keep their eyes on the prize," Leclair said. "I saw that tonight with guys bouncing back for wins when we needed them."

Central received three wins apiece from juniors Jaden Van Maanen (31-1) and Connor Williams (31-1), but only recorded one victory.

Aquinas senior Isiah Brown (21-8), who has been wrestling at 195, bumped up to 220 and recorded an impressive pin against Logan senior Nathan Bakalars (32-6). He also tested himself against Onalaska's Konrad Ernst (28-1), but Ernst walked away with a 9-0 victory.

Ernst pinned his other two opponents in 2:31 and 3:03 to continue his strong season. One of those pins was against Bakalars.

"I think this was a wakeup call for Bakalars, which is a good thing," Leclair said. "He was challenged, and they got the better of him. He's having a great year, but I think this just shows him that there is still work to be done."

Campton, Cashton have strong start to postseason



Being thrown into the 285-pound weight class as a freshman can be traumatizing to any wrestler.

There are certainly success stories, and maybe the case can be made that the lumps taken when younger can lead to plenty of success during the second half of a varsity career.

That's what Cashton High School junior Dylan Campton is turning his situation into as he pursues his first appearance in the WIAA individual state meet later this month.

Campton (25-12) only had to wrestle one match at Saturday's Division 3 Aquinas regional, but the performance was an impressive second-period pin of Aquinas senior Isiah Brown (25-9) in the 220-pound final as the Eagles rolled to a team championship.

"I'd wrestled with (Brown) at camps before, so I knew he was strong," Campton said. "I was ready to go six minutes, and I was going to try and tire him out.

"That's what we do. Our practices are hard, and we work on conditioning for matches like the ones we're wrestling now."

The Eagles showed they are ready for the postseason by advancing all 12 of their regional entrants to next Saturday's Mineral Point sectional. Cashton dominated the regional with a team score of 279, which was well ahead of second-place Westby (151).

That championships gives the Eagles a berth in the team sectional Tuesday at Royall. Unranked Cashton meets eighth-ranked New Lisbon in the semifinal and either third-ranked Fennimore or unranked Darlington/Black Hawk for the championship immediately after — if it wins.

The Eagles won eight weight classes at Aquinas and showed dominance with a lineup that was nearly full. That's not bad for a school with an enrollment of 155.

But it wouldn't happen without wrestlers like Campton, who took one for the team as a freshman 285-pounder.

“Dylan was part of the youth program, and I knew him pretty well,” Cashton coach Phil Flock said. “That made me more comfortable putting him in there. I thought he could handle it.”

Campton, who said he weighed 230 pounds that year, won 27 matches. The emergence of Brandon Klimek — he won at 285 Saturday to improve to 35-5 — allowed Campton to drop to 220 as a junior.

The offensive and defensive lineman toyed with the idea of dropping to 195 for this season, but it was too much of a cut.

“I was weaker when I dropped down,” Campton said. “I feel stronger and healthier at 220, and I feel like I can wrestle my way. I can be more physical and go for it, and you can’t do that if you feel weak.”

Klimek’s emergence gave Cashton a strong one-two punch to close out invitationals, and that was the case on Saturday. Klimek finished Aquinas freshman Bryce Lee in just over a minute in his final.

Josh Korn (32-8, 106 pounds), Ethan Leis (29-10, 126), Henry Whitehead (9-2, 132), Gabe Anderson (30-12, 145), Jeffry Janzen (32-8, 152) and Jaden Schmitz (36-8, 182) also won regional titles for Cashton.

Bjorn Leum (18-16, 113) and Collin Lenzner (23-18, 138) won for Westby, Aaron Raabe (28-1, 120) for Onalaska Luther and Lance Buckles (35-4, 170) for De Soto.

Aquinas sends four wrestlers to the Mineral Point sectional after Ethan Reid (22-10, 152), Peter Riley (12-9, 170), Brown (25-9) and Lee (3-5) all placed second.

“Riley was kind of a surprise for us, only because he’s been dinged up, and we didn’t know if he’d be able to wrestle today,” Aquinas coach Deke Stanek said. “He has a pretty sore ribcage, but he got cleared early this week, and we left it up to him to compete.

“We had a spot open up at 170, and he took advantage.”

Stanek was also able to relate to Campton’s path because he has someone he believes has a bright future in Lee, who didn’t wrestle until last year and joined the team a couple of weeks after the first practice this year. He has split his matches between 220 and 285.

“It’s a tough thing to do with a kid that age wrestling at that weight,” Stanek said. “You have to be careful because we really push retention and want to keep them wrestling.

“You don’t want to send them out there only for matches they will win, but you also don’t want to send them out there against the best guys because it can hurt their confidence if they aren’t ready for it.”

Campton was ready then, and the experience appears to have made him more ready now.

MADISON -- Aquinas High School senior Isiah Brown fought his way to overtime, but Fennimore's Cody McCollough had one last takedown in him in a WIAA Division 3 220-pound third-place wrestling match Saturday at the Kohl Center.

Brown (31-12) tied their match on a reversal with about 30 seconds left in the third period, but McCollough took him down in overtime to score an 8-6 victory at the individual state meet.

"It was hard to get back in it, but I did," Brown said. "Then he got the duck under on me. It's not the way I wanted to end the season."

But the season was a good one for Brown, who was pinned by McCollough in a sectional match the week before.

"My goal was to get to state this year because I'm a senior," Brown said. "I did more than that."

The West Salem/Bangor team closed out Saturday's early session by winning all three of its Division 2 placement matches.

Freshman Dalton Schams (44-10, 106 pounds) won a third-place bout, and freshman Aaron Bahr (45-7, 120) and senior Nathan Schomberg (38-11, 138) won fifth-place matches after losing consolation semifinals Saturday morning.

Prairie du Chien/Wauzeka senior Clayton Beers (40-6, 120) claimed third place in Division 2 after pinning Bahr in the consolation semifinal. Brookwood's Cory Ottum (37-4, 195) also won his third-place match in Division 3.

Extra Effort: Aquinas senior learns to compete in classroom, too



It took some time for academics to click for Isiah Brown.

The question was never his intelligence or ability, but rather his dedication.

“I didn’t think it was important,” the Aquinas High School senior said. “I didn’t do my homework very much.”

Athletics opened Brown’s eyes and made him hit the books. His response since that moment is what made Brown his school’s winner of the La Crosse Tribune Extra Effort Award.

If he wanted to play, he had to work harder and study more, and that’s what he’s done while competing in football, wrestling and track and field for the Blugolds.

Brown is hoping for a college future that includes athletics, and he has been offered scholarship money to compete in track and field at NCAA Division II Southwest Minnesota State University in Marshall. Football is still a possibility, too.

“Over the last three years that I’ve had him, he’s matured a lot as a young man,” Aquinas wrestling coach Deke Stanek said. “We hold him to a high standard, and he is always becoming more and more accountable.

“I think the problem was that he was just apathetic toward school, but I think the success he had last season in wrestling and track and this season in football showed him that he is capable of doing great things.”

Aquinas football coach Tom Lee thinks Brown can be a good football fit for a college team, but Brown has made his biggest athletic impact at Aquinas in track and field.

He placed third in the Mississippi Valley Conference last spring as a 110-meter hurdler, and he not only qualified for the WIAA state meet at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, but he placed seventh in the Division 2 finals.

Brown was only able to do that by concentrating more on school.

“I had Mr. Lee for freshman history, and him being a football coach helped,” Brown said. “He was really good at offering encouragement.”

Lee is known for his positive outlook and demeanor when it comes to coaching. He is serious about what he teaches and commands the focus and attention of his players. Lee offers a very realistic picture of what happens, but he also finds something useful to emphasize a brighter future.

“He’s an awesome guy and super-talented,” Lee said of Brown, who plans to study computer science. “He had to figure some things out himself before anyone else could help him. What he figured out was that if he wanted to compete, he had to stay eligible.

“That was the start. If he wanted to do something that was fun, he had to realize that he had to do something that was more important first.”

Brown grew up in La Crosse as an only child with his mom, Angela. He said he never really knew his father.

“It’s always been just the two of us,” Brown said.

He became interested in athletics at a young age and started wrestling as a kindergartner. Brown said wrestling was big in his family after some of his uncles wrestled at La Crescent.

“All of my uncles wrestled, and that’s how I got into it,” said Brown, who went 18-16 after taking over as Aquinas’ varsity 182-pounder as a sophomore.

Brown was 24-10 as a junior and placed fourth at 182 pounds in the Blugolds’ Division 3 sectional meet. He’s 19-7 at 195 this season and finished second in the Arcadia Raider Challenge last weekend.

He has found a way to apply that success in sports, specifically wrestling, when it comes to academics.

“There’s a mindset I try to get into when I wrestle,” Brown said. “When I have homework I have to get done, I just try to do the same thing.”
